- ▽ **How to use a rasp and the care of your tools**
- ▽ **The safety zones of a horse and proper way of lifting the hoof and the farriers proper stance of holding a hoof without hurting your back or getting kicked**
- ▽ **We train with the use of a cadaver hoof, then use the learned techniques on a live horse**
